UFO Update

Director search is down to two candidates. Final interviews will take place in mid-February

PaCE:

- Program will have approx. 50 majors. These were chosen based on Deans and Associate Deans response to Dr. Harfe. If you see changes to be made or concerns, please email Dr. Harfe.
- Engineering and Education have chosen not to add majors to PaCE from their colleges
- Students cannot apply to PaCE. They are picked from FTIC applicant pool.
- Admissions will use a holistic approach when selecting students for acceptance. This is the same approach they use for residential students. GPA can be “as low as 3.4”
- When in UF Online for PaCE, students are treated as UF Online students (no athletic tickets, bus, gym etc. privileges).
- Only students who selected a PaCE major on their FTIC application are candidates for the program. Students who selected “undecided” or “exploratory” will also be in the pool.
- If we were running PaCE for fall 2014 applicants, approximately 1500 offers would have been made
- The yield is unknown
- Once in PaCE, students:
 - Can transfer to any other PaCE major, or a UF Online major that is not PACE, as long as they are meeting program requirements.
 - Can transition to campus ONLY in one of the PaCE majors
 - Must stay in UF Online for 2 terms – could be on campus as soon as Summer A 2016
 - Must have 60 credits to transfer to campus
 - Must take at least 15 credits in UF Online
- HSAA’s will be excluded, at least at first
- The PaCE degree/diploma is identical to residential – just like in UF Online
- UF Admissions will handle initial conversations with students about PaCE.
- When the student is ready to sign acceptance papers, the One Stop will step in to help navigate the process. The One Stop will get students in touch with the proper Enrollment Coaches
- If you receive a call, PaCE students should NOT become involved with Pearson until after the letter is signed
- Discussion about process – point brought up that once on campus in a PaCE major, students could attempt to back-door the major they really want (i.e. Bio, EG, etc.)

Other:

Melissa (One Stop)

- Deferment form is working well
- If they identify a lower division student, if they have 45+ credits, One Stop will scan the transcript and send to the college advisor so the advisor can discuss with the student the possibility of finishing the AA degree and if that's the right course of action for that student.
