

UF Online Advising Group Meeting
Thursday 1/29/15, 2:00 PM, 200 Farrior Hall

Updates:

1. UFO – General.....Summerford
Interviewing 2 candidates in a few weeks. PaCE is coming online. Announcements go out the 13th of Feb.
Marketing and Recruitment are going strong.
If everyone wants to look at the PaCE majors for their college and the course offerings, and give any feedback to TJ that would be great. Hard to know how to scale for advising on PaCE until we get some numbers after offers go out. TJ will send out the promo and contract documents to the group.
Every effort will be made to explain to the students what the program is about and what the limitations are.
2. Student Affairs.....Mastrodicasa
Kris can email the students directly in Jeanna’s absence. If you need something sent out, let Kris know.
3. Links Orientation and PaCE students.....Gresley
PaCE students will first go through LINKS, and they will get an automated email when it’s time to register. All UF Online students will get that email, eliminating the need for it to be done by hand.
Students will then come through the UF Online student experience. When they meet the requirements, they will come through a session similar to the H.S. AA session at Preview. It gets all the advising done at the department/college level, but keeps them in the loop for the general information as well.
For the summer A or spring semester residential transfers from PaCE, the session will be a hybrid model to meet their needs. Summer B and Fall transfers from PaCE will go through traditional programming.
Students have until May 1st to let us know if they are attending.
LINKS will open mid-March for summer A, and early May for summer B and fall
Students will be able to see app status on Feb 13th after business hours.
4. UF Online One Stop Center.....Robinson
Melissa created an internal calendar for when certain processes need to happen and laid the deadlines out.

6/1 app deadline
6/15 file completion deadline
7/10 decision deadline
7/24 welcome call deadline
7/31 TE deadline (transcripts posted)
This leaves us 3 solid weeks for advising incoming students with having transcripts posted.

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The text above is only updated for UF Online students. The link in the audit takes them to the handbook webpage which explains the foreign language requirements for admissions and tells students to talk to an advisor about specific colleges. Updates to the handbook wording should be sent to TJ.

Discussion continued about how to approach verification of other language proficiency for the colleges that require foreign language for graduation.

6. Colleges/departments.....All

Brain Marchman – ProctorU update – short term (6months) contract has been signed that puts ProctorU as our primary proctoring service. Piloting program with external cameras to help with academic integrity. An external camera gives more of a picture of what’s happening in the area that will help ensure integrity. Up to 4 pilot courses, with the goal being requiring an external camera from all UF Online students. Administrative processes are being worked out. The minimum computer requirements will support the plug and play activity of the camera. Currently I pads can be used with ProctorU, but will need an external camera once this rolls out fully. UF Online will provide the cameras.

Discussion Items:

1. Post-bacc students – Pearson’s policy is to immediately refer students to the respective college as soon as they learn a student is a post-bacc. Is this working for you?
Most colleges are fine with the current process. Most colleges don’t have many post-bac students.
2. For UF Online, summer admission is viewed a little differently than for residential students. Regardless of which summer term a student is admitted, they can change to any other summer term without reapplying or deferring. What implications does this have for advising students about the new State Gen-ed Core that becomes effective Summer B 2015?
