Updates

1. UFO – General
 - a. Fall Registration Trends – TJ's report
 - i. 84% of PaCE students have registered
 - ii. went over the registration report by Pearson. Glenn will share that with group when he receives it every other week.
 - iii. 680 left to register including all populations
 - c. Glenn will listen in on Pearson welcome call this week. Others are welcome to do so
2. Student Affairs
 - a. There will be a virtual graduate career fair on Oct 15th – will mirror in person fair
 - b. Kim is working to find out if UF Online students are eligible to purchase student health insurance – will get definitive answers and let us know. Likely will depend on where the student is physically located
3. Links Orientation
 - a. Of 525 new students eligible for advising (either completed or have it deferred), 409 have
 - b. PaCE 257 students eligible, 92.5% have completed advising
 - c. Have purchased the CRP textbook code for FTICs in UFO and PaCE, should have it by tomorrow and will go out tomorrow or Monday via email so they can redeem the code for a digital download of the book
 - d. FYF offered again this fall, will advertise it to new students but anyone is welcome to take it
 - e. Convocation is next Friday, doors open at 8am, ceremony at 9:30am, everyone is welcome. PaCE and UF Online students are welcome to attend or stream online but are not required to attend
 - f. CALS is doing a live breakout session after Convocation for students who are here
4. UF Online One Stop Center
 - a. Year in Review Stats
 - i. Shared 2014-2015 Activity Summary
5. Colleges/departments
 - a. Kari from WCBA led a virtual panel discussion with new UFO admits for fall who were not able to attend the live orientation.
 - i. Went very well and students were engaged

- ii. Had about 50 students – would have been more if I-75 hadn't been shut down unexpectedly that day
 - iii. Great learning tool for WCBA for future sessions
 - b. Deferment reminder – if a student takes classes after deferring, it's no longer a deferral. They have to reapply at that point
- 7. Curriculum Monitoring - Toby
 - a. PaCE transition – for summer transitions has to start in spring term, because it has to happen before advance registration
 - b. Working on the process, refining things now, then will train folks on how to do the transitions
 - c. Students will receive a hold letting them know that they should have a discussion with their advisor about transition
 - d. Advisors will have the authority to waive requirements to allow students to transition even if not everything is met.
 - e. Advisors will have the ability to put them back into PaCE if they don't meet the requirements that were planned
 - f. Update on State Core Gen Ed – looking at broadening the lens on AMH2020 with social science. Not for students who have taken it at UF previously. Doing this from the perspective of what is in the best interest of UF students.
