- 1) Approval of 1/26 minutes (attached)
  - a) Minutes have been approved.
- 2) UFO Deadlines, Events, Reminders, and Announcements – (Glenn)
  - a) PaCE (General)
    - i) Colleges will likely receive the PaCE list on Monday.
      - (1) Target is 500 students accepting the offer.
    - ii) Review FAQ's
    - iii) Enough work to go around – we all play an important role (Enrollment Management, DOS Office, UF Online, Colleges, Departments)
    - iv) ROTC and PaCE
      - (1) Students can do ROTC, but there is a lot of coordination involved.
    - v) BFA in Art (new this year!)
      - (1) PaCE hybrid.
      - (2) Students need to be near enough to Gainesville to attend live, in-person studio courses.
      - (3) All of the 7 BFA art specializations are available.
      - (4) If you have a student deciding between Art and another major, please encourage those students to start with Art.
        - (a) It is more difficult to switch into Art later than start with Art and switch into another major.

      - (1) The consistent message should be that PaCE was designed for the majors offered in the program.
        - (a) Students have been happiest in the program when they are interested in pursuing one of the available majors.
      - (2) Important to be honest with students and make them aware of this up front.

        - (a) Students taking in person Art classes are required to submit their immunization documents.
