- 1) UFO Updates and News – (TJ)
 - a) TJ added a Graduates report to the reports site
 - i) It can be viewed by current or previous terms, as well as by college.
 - b) The new UF Online website is live.
 - i) If you have any ideas, comments, corrections, etc. please don't hesitate to send your feedback to Kathy, TJ, Jen, or Alejandra.
 - c) Clarification: Communication Sciences and Disorders (CMS) is starting in Fall 2017, although current CSD students will not be brought in to UF Online.
 - i) Fall 2017: FTIC students will be admitted to the UF Online CMS program.
 - ii) Fall 2018: FTIC and Lower Division transfer students will be admitted to the UF Online CMS program.
 - iii) Fall 2019: FTIC, Lower Division, and Upper Division transfer students will be admitted.
 - iv) This program will not allow for Spring admits.

 - e) Drop deadline falls right in middle of Junior and Sophomore registration appointments – Be Aware!
 - f) Summer/Fall course updates
 - i) 180 Good life seats in Summer for all current students still needing course. Good Life seats in Fall reserved for PaCE students only – Advise current students to take it in Summer!
 - ii) CLAS added close to 700 additional seats in ANT, ECO, GER, SPN, ENC, POS, SPC, SYG courses for Fall
 - iii) COTA IP of adding 100 additional seats in ARH, MUH, and MUL courses for Fall
 - iv) Let Glenn know of courses and caps of concern ASAP

- g) Advisors will need to clear the PaCE Preview hold after transitioning any PaCE 16 students (the job was set up for 2015 cohort and automatically adds this hold when the student is transitioned. It would take significant time to reprogram, so advisors are being asked to do this manually for each student they transition).
 - i) Advisors should not remove holds for 2015 students since they still will have to attend a transfer preview prior to transitioning.
 - ii) We are not sure if PaCE 2016 students who are transitioning for Summer will be able to advance register for Summer and Fall.
 - (1) If you have a PaCE 2016 student who is not able to advance register, let Glenn and Kris know and they will work with the Registrar's Office to try and manually expire the UFO Cohort.
 - h) CLAS hired a new UF Online advisor to fill the vacant line. Laura Beth Lancaster will start on April 4.
- 3) Student Success Initiatives (Meredith)
- a) Meredith went to the UF Coral Gables office a few weeks ago and met with between 40-50 PaCE students and families.
 - i) The response was very positive and the majority of students she met with were very interested in the program.
 - b) March 25th event- UF Online Connections event in Coral Gables
 - i) If anyone wants to come to the event (and have their department pay for it), they are more than welcome to attend.
 - ii) It is a networking event for current UF Online students and alumni.
 - c) The April 29th graduation reception is moving forward as planned!
 - i) If you have a graduate coming to graduation, and your college would like to recognize them, this reception is a good opportunity to do so.
 - ii) The graduation invite has not yet been sent out.
 - iii) Meredith will send it to the UFO advising listserv so advisors can encourage students to attend.
- 4) PaCE (Meredith, Nicole)
- a) The first Florida Days event is this Monday, March 13th.
 - b) There will be a PaCE breakout session (3 for each Florida Days event).
 - c) We'll have student representatives on hand.
 - d) We'll also encourage students to attend the college breakout sessions as well, so they can get information from both the colleges as well as any PaCE specific information.
- 5) Marketing/Communication (Kathy)
- a) The new UF Online website is live!
 - i) The new website provides more detail compared to the old website.
 - ii) The plan is to provide clearer information regarding pre-requisites, to hopefully better inform students about the requirements and reduce the denial rate.
 - iii) The ROC team and advisors were instrumental in providing feedback regarding the functionality of the website from the student perspective.
- 6) Career Resource Center (Natalie, Kelly)
- a) Student Affairs update: the MCDA director search is still underway, and Will Atkins is still serving as the interim director.

- i) Searches for LGBTQ affairs, Black affairs, and Asian and Pacific Islander affairs directors are underway as well.
 - b) There was a virtual PhD fair, and UF had the 2nd highest attendance of any institution.
- 7) Links Orientation (Kris)
 - a) Links for UF Online for Summer admits will go live on Monday, March 13th.
 - i) Kris will send out a notification once it has gone live.
 - b) PaCE 2017 students who have submitted their tuition deposit can now register for Preview.
 - i) They can register once they've confirmed and submitted the deposit.
 - ii) They'll receive an email about how to register for Preview after they've been confirmed.
 - iii) Students will not receive the brochure with the Preview dates until they've submitted their deposit.
 - iv) The PaCE Preview dates will not be made public.
 - v) If you work with out of state/out of country PaCE students, or none of the available dates work for that student, have them contact Kris directly.
