- 1) Approval of 8/24 minutes and Quiz

- 2) UFO Deadlines, Events, Reminders, and Announcements – (Glenn)
 - a) Commitment To Academic Integrity

 - b) PaCE 2018 changes
 - i) Some Music majors have been added.
 - ii) Dance is returning as a major.
 - iii) Additional art majors have been added as well.
 - iv) These will all be hybrid programs, where students must live in Gainesville and attend live studio classes on campus.
 - (1) Messaging will go out to students interested in these programs to make sure they are aware of the on campus requirement.
 - (2) All of the College of the Arts majors, with the exception of Art History, will be the hybrid PaCE model.
 - v) Digital Arts and Sciences will no longer be a PaCE major.
- 3) PaCE (Meredith, Nicole)
 - a) The PaCE student group had their first meeting of the semester this week.

- 4) Marketing/Communication (TJ on behalf of Kathy)
 - a) Latest on Irma Communication Plan
 - i) Evie sent an email yesterday to all UF Online staff and faculty.
 - ii) The UF Online faculty members have now all been added to the Plaza.
 - iii) The philosophy has been to follow the lead of the UF administration regarding messaging.
 - (1) Any of the information that is being sent to students is also being added to the Plaza.
 - iv) The UF homepage is updated regularly, and the GATOR SAFE app is also being updated.

- 5) Career Resource Center (Kelly)
 - a) 375 employers have committed to participating in the CRC Showcase.
 - b) CRC is in the process of planning the “Beyond the Swamp” Graduate School fair.
 - i) The Virtual Graduate School fair is on October 18th.
- 6) Links Orientation (Kris, Kayleigh)
 - a) Links is currently closed but it will be going through its standard review.
 - b) Preview staffer applications are open, and will be open until next Friday.
 - i) Please encourage your PaCE students to apply!
 - ii) In order to be eligible, PaCE students must have transitioned to campus for the Spring 2018.
- 7) Enrollment Management: ROC & OneStop (Melissa, Daniel, Victoria)
 - a) Victoria Houghton, new Assistant Director of the ROC, introduces herself to the group.
 - i) The ROC hired another admissions officer, Sterling Davenport.
 - ii) The ROC is in the process of hiring 2 additional admissions officers as well.
 - iii) Last week, ROC representatives attended state college fairs.
 - iv) Information Sessions
 - (1) The information sessions for next Monday and Tuesday (September 11th and 12th) have been cancelled.
 - (2) So far, the night information sessions have been particularly well attended (up to 80 students).
 - (3) If you would like more information about what the ROC presents in the information session, please let the Daniel and/or Victoria know.
 - b) Melissa is recovering from surgery and should be back next week.
 - c) Melissa will send out Fall enrollment numbers next week.
 - i) 2872 enrollments this Fall, a 28% year over year growth in Fall registration.
 - d) Spring files should be going out soon, so please notify your decision makers to prepare for incoming applications to review.
 - e) For Fall 2018, students will be using the new application system.
 - i) Daniel can provide you with instructions on how to navigate the new application if you are interested.
 - ii) The new student records and registration system will also start in Fall 2018.
 - (1) It shouldn’t be a big change for students, since one.uf should be similar, but it will be different for faculty and staff.

Message about UF Online’s Commitment to Academic Integrity, from Evie:

Please share my goal of making our students aware of our “zero tolerance” policy for cheating in UF Online. We’ll emphasize that by working with the colleges and Student affairs to appropriately weave that messaging up front into our orientation, preview, welcome events and UF Plaza content. I’d like to better communicate with students what “cheating” means with simple tips, reminders and an informational video – borrowing from experts in the field already. And we’ll continue that theme throughout the UF Online student experience.

This isn’t a change in policy this is a better communication and emphasis on this broader UF policy – against cheating – in improved ways to reach online students. This will complement the

effort of that broader academic advising committee but we'll make these changes in time for fall 2018 onboarding.
