Housing

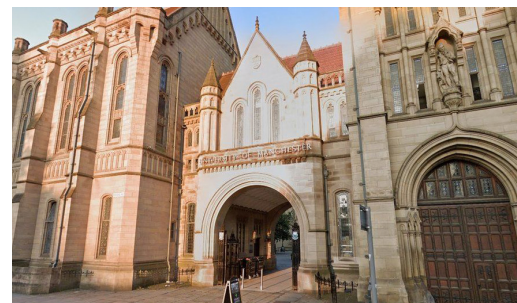
Manchester University offers a wide range of accommodation, ranging from "self catered" apartments to residential dorms with a meal plan.

Application Deadlines

Fall: early May

Academic Year: early May

Spring: mid October

Note: Some exchange programs have earlier deadlines

Tuition

Tuition at the host school is waived for exchange students, who instead pay tuition directly to the University of Florida at their usual tuition rate.

Financial Aid

University of Florida students needing financial aid should apply through UF Student Financial Affairs. Normal eligibility for aid may be used while studying abroad as an exchange student. This includes using the Bright Futures scholarship and the Florida Pre-Paid College Plan.

Scholarships

For fall, spring, and academic-year scholarships administered by the University of Florida International Center, the deadlines for application are: early March for programs starting in fall; and early October for programs starting in spring. Applications forms are available on the UF International Center web site: www.internationalcenter.ufl.edu.

Health Insurance

Students will be billed for mandatory international health insurance which includes emergency medical assistance.

Fees Due

A \$425 non-refundable fee is required within seven days of applying online. Students who will receive financial aid may contact the University of Florida International Center to arrange deferment until the disbursement of their financial aid.
