*This plan is for students wanting to enter UF Pharmacy School after completing the pre-requisites and general education requirements. The UF College of Pharmacy does not award undergraduate degrees. To obtain a bachelor's degree, students must declare a major in an undergraduate degree awarding college and may complete the courses listed on this **suggested course timeline**:

The following document is only a suggestion and students are responsible for knowing the admissions requirements of the individual schools of interest. Additionally, not all AA degree requirements are listed on the plan.

*UF students that declare Pre-Pharmacy as a track and do not plan to declare a major as stated above should follow the **2-year pre-pharmacy track** outlined here. Please be aware that this track does not lead to a degree in pharmacy and is intended to help students complete the preprofessional coursework required for entry into UF pharmacy school. After completing this track, students may apply for their Associates of Arts (A.A) degree. Kept in mind that an A.A is the minimum requirement for many schools of Pharmacy, this includes UF's Pharmacy program.*
